Know all men by these presents that I Alexander Ramsey of the State of North Carolina, Rutherford County one of the executors of the Estate of John Ramsey Sr deceased in consideration of the sum of twenty three dollars to me in hand paid by Joseph G Smith of the State and District aforesaid have Granted bargained sold released and Deeded and by the presents do grant bargain sell deed and released unto the said Joseph G Smith all that tract or parcel of land containing by estimation forty two acres to be the same more or less it being the distribution share of Abraham Ramsay, dec. which was left to him by the will of John Ramsay Sen Dec, and sold by said Abraham Ramsey in his life time to David Ramsay and the same by David Ramsey to Joseph G Smith. Beginning on a Black Jack or Black Oak running S 85 W 12 to a Black Oak thence N 12 W 20 to a Post Oak thence S 76 E 15 to a pine thence S 9 W 22 to the beginning. Bounded East by Ramsay land on the North end by ??? land on the West side by Jese Sandling's land and on the South by Joseph G Smith's land formerly belonged to David Ramsay together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph G Smith his heirs and assigns fagainst myself and my heirs against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof in witness my hand and Seal this 4<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year or our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty nine and in the fifty third and fifty fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
