

August the 14th 1811 No 109

This indenture made this first Day of January in the year of our Lord, 1805 between Dennis Carrol of the one part and Henry Dye of the other part & -----Rutherford County of the other part.-----

That the said Dennis Carrol sold & in consideration with the sum of one hundred dollars the receipt whereof the said Carrol doth acknowledge himself fully satisfied & contented & paid. Hath given grant bargain sold & delivered & by these -----Doth give grant bargain deliver & confirm unto him the said Henry Dye to him his heirs (4C) forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate & lying & being in the County aforesaid State of North Carolina on the Millstone Fork of Sandy Run Beginning on a pine by his corner stake thence No 14 E 50 poles to a post oak on Benjamin -----line then No. 76-160 poles to a B O (Black Oak) No.14 W 150 Poles to a pine then No.76W 80 poles to a stake in ----to line Thence Said line No.14 E 100 poles to a stake thence to the beginning containing one hundred acres together with all -----privileges & appurtenances there unto belonging to or any wise appertaining to have & to hold use Occupy popy's & land the same with every part & parcel henceforth and proper use &-----him the said Henry Dye his heirs & C Forever against him to Said Dennis Carrol his heirs & C against the claim & demand of all & every person or persons whatsoever-----& will & by these presents warrant & forever -----the said Dennis Carrol hath here unto set his hand & affixed his seal this Day & Date above written signed & sealed in the presence of :
