To any Regular Minister of the Gospel having the care of Souls, or to any Justice of the Peace for said County—Greeting :

These are to Authorize you to solemnize the RITE OF MATRIMONY between D. Boswell and Miss N. L. Avery of your County, agreeably to an Act of Assembly, in such cases made and provided; Provided always, that the said N. L. Avery be an actual resident of this County; otherwise, these shall be null and void, and shall not be accounted any license or authority to you, or either of you, for the purpose aforesaid, more than though the same had never been prayed or granted.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we D. Boswell & J. T. Stumps all of the County of Crockett, and State of Tennessee, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Tennessee in the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and each and every one of us, and them, jointly and severally by these presents.

Witness our hands and seals, this 17 day of July 1879

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That whereas, the above named D. Boswell has this day prayed and obtained license to marry N. L. Avery Now, if the said N. L. Avery be an actual resident of the aforesaid County, and there shall not appear any lawful cause why the said D. Boswell and N. L. Avery should not be joined in holy matrimony as husband and wife, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
