bequeath to my three Married Daughters namely Susannah Lockman
Mary Withers and Catherine Graham one feather Bed each of
them well furnished with Bed clothes and each of them a Cow and
Calf which they have already received I also give and bequeath
unto my Daughter Charlotte Boswell one feather Bed and furniture and one
Cow and Calf when called for my will is that my Son Thomas Boswell
shall have one Hundred Dollars more and above the rest of my Children
to be taken from the State of the Remainder of my Estate I also
give and bequeath unto my Daughter Thomas Boswell two Dollars
I also give and bequeath this to my Daughter James Withers in whole
my will is that all the Rest of my Estate Lands and my stock of various
kinds of Cattle Horses and that of every Description together with
Houses hold and Household furniture and all plantations Trees and

of my Children Father, my will is that if my Grand Daughter
Juliana Prochers should not live to arrive to be Eighteen years
old the part of my Estate left to her in this my Last Will shall Return

The Will of Edward Boswell of Orange Co NC

In the name of God Amen

I Edward Boswell of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina being weak of the body but of sound mind and perfect memory Blessed be God for the same do make and publish this my last will and testement, in manner and form following (viz) 1st my will is that my just debts shall be satisfied & contented. 2nd I give and bequeath to my two eldest sons Craven and John, and Mary Boswell widow of my son Thomas Boswell, deceased, each of them a horse and each of them a bed and furniture belonging to the same which they are already in possession, I also give and bequeath to my three other sons, Edward, Matthew and James, each of them a horse which they already received and also give each of them one bed, and furniture which they already received, I also give and bequeath to my Grandson, Brown Boswell, a good horse and one bed and furniture . I also give and bequeath to my three married daughters, namely Susannah Leachman, Nancy Wilkerson, and Catherine Graham, one feather bed each of the will furnished with bed clothes and each of them a cow and calf, which they have already received, I also give and bequeath to my daughter Charlotte Boswell, one feather bed and furniture and one cow and calf when called for , My Will is that my son, Thomas Boswell, shall, have 100 dollars over and above the rest of my children, and to be ceased from the Sale of the remainder of my estate, I also I also give and bequeath unto my Son in Law Thomas Sulivan one dollar I also give and bequeath to my Son in Law James Wilkerson, one dollar, My Will is that all the best of my estate lands and my stock of negroes stock of cattle horses and stock of every description together with household and kitchen furniture and all plantation tools all shall be sold at Public Auction and the money arising from such sale shall be equally divided amongst the following persons My sons Craven, John, Edward, Matthew and James Boswell also my Grandson Brown Boswell My daughters Susannah Leachman, Charlotte, my granddaughter Julie Ann Bracken, Catherine Graham, my Grandchildren, William and Craven Sulivan, Nancy Catherine and Elizabeth Sulivan, these few to draw one 12th part of the money arising from the afforesaid mentioned sale and to be equally divided amongst them , I also give and bequeath unto my Daughter in Law Mary Boswell, widow of my son Thomas Boswell, one equal share with the rest of my children, . Further my will is that grand daughter Julie Ann Bracken should not live to arise to be Eighteen years old the part of my estate left her in this my last will shall return and be divided equally amongst all the rest of the {Sagattees?} and lastly I revoke all other wills By me made heretofore and I do consider and appoint my son James Boswell and Gorge Graham my joint executors of this my last will and testement in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and affixed my seal this 3rd Day of January in the year of our Lord, 1826 and declared in the Presents of us who were present at the signing and (ordering of the same.
