Elizabeth was born May 1857 in Bledsoe Co, TN and died after 1920 near Cape Girardeau, MO.

She was the oldest daughter of Alfred Burton Dye and Sarah L Gilbreath.

She married Napoleon B Boswell on Aug 9, 1874 in Crockett Co, TN.

Napoleon was the son of John Thomas Boswell and Elizabeth Pully.

Napoleon was born Dec 4, 1853 in Giles Co, TN and died Feb 22, 1901 in Holcomb, Dunklin Co, MO and is buried at Loyd's Cemetery. The Boswell Family came from Caswell Co, NC into Giles Co, TN.

From there they resided most of Napoleon's “growing up” years at Gibson Co, TN.

This district of Gibson Co, TN near Crockett Mills, became part of Crockett Co, TN.

Napoleon's parents are buried at Quincy Cemetery in Crockett Co, TN.

He married Lora Elliott in Clay Co, AR Nov 29, 1895.

Lora was born 1877 and she remarried to F C Craft Jan 13, 1898 in Clay Co, AR

Elizabeth “Eliza Beth” Boswell b. May 1883 d. bef. 1905

She married James S Redding Sep 6, 1901 at Dunklin Co, MO.

William Riley Boswell b. Aug 23, 1884 Holcomb, Dunklin Co, MO d. Jan 31, 1921 Kennett, Dunklin Co, MO. He married Annie M Griffin b. 1894 d. 1939 November 24, 1910 in Kennett, Dunklin Co, MO. He was of Medium build with the Gray-Blue Eyes and Black hair according to his WWI registration card. Annie remarried after his death to M C “Mack” Young. They are all buried at Oak Ridge Cemetery at Kennett, MO. With Annie between the two men. Children of William & Annie Boswell are: Mildred, Willard & Maxine Boswell. Annie & Mack Young: William “Bill” W Young b. 1925

Minnie Pearl Boswell b. Oct 29, 1887 d. May 18, 1977 buried at Loyd Cemetery, Dunklin Co, MO married David Thomas Dye son of John Dye and Sarah Ann Rice on February 7, 1906 at Bonicord, Dyer Co, TN. Children: John David, Alma Rita, Pauline Elizabeth, Halloween & Anna Louise Dye.

Mollie M Boswell b. Sep 4, 1892 d. Oct 21, 1990 buried at Lightner Cemetery, Illmo, Scott Co, MO She married Francis H White “Frank” Dec 28, 1912 at Pemiscot Co, MO Two Children from this marriage Francis Boswell, daughter and Boswell White, son. She was married to George Cruse and Rome Pate, both men are buried at the same cemetery.

Myrtle L Boswell b. Feb 21, 1896 d. June 1978 in Hughes, OK.

She married Thomas Gordon Watson, son of Smith & Cynthia Watson, Dec 14, 1913.

Tom was born Dec 24, 1893 at Lutesville, MO and died due to an automobile accident on

November 19, 1924. Myrtle had a short marriage to a man referred to as “Scrap” Bullock. Myrtle and Tom had two children: Yvonne Watson Harper and William Carl Watson.
