

TENNESSEE STATE MARRIAGES, 1780-2002

KNOW ALL MEN, that we *Isaiah Swindell* and *Isaiah Swindell*
of the county of *Wilson* and state of
Tennessee, are held and firmly bound unto the Governor of the said state, for the time
being, in the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars, to be paid to his excellency, his
successors in office, or assigns; to which payment well and truly to be made, we bind
ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, and each and every of us and them,
both jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Witness our hands and seals the
6th day of *February* 1821
The condition of the above obligation is such, ~~that whereas~~ *Isaiah Swindell*
hath prayed and obtained license to marry *Juliann Hickman*
Now if the said *Juliann Hickman* be an actual resi-
dent in the aforesaid county, and there shall not hereafter appear any lawful cause why
the said *Isaiah Swindell* & *Juliann Hickman*
should not be joined together in Holy Matrimony, as husband and wife, then this obliga-
tion to be void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
