The deposition of James T Boswell taken before the clerk master of the chancery court of Pulaski upon and order of reference in the above named case _____ being a sworn said witness aged 43 years being first sworn deposes as follows:

Int 1: Are you one of Roger Simpson's Grandchildren ? and what relation are you to Jno D Boswell ?

Ans: I am one of Roger Simpson's grandchildren and Jno D Boswell was my brother.

Int 2: Have you and your brother Jno D ever received the \$100.00 given to you by said Grandfather's Will?

If so, When & from whom? And how do you know that Jno D. Boswell received \$100.00 coming to

To him?

Ans: I received mine from John F Simpson Exor. & gave him my receipt which will show the date of payment. I heard my brother Jno. D Boswell say that he had received the amount due him from the Executor, that he had bought some things at the sale and owed the estate as much as a hundred dollars

And that he considered himself paid, although no receipts had passed between them. He first told me this in 1872 and afterwards told me the same thing several times. My brother died in 1875 or 1876.

He said it was a piece of carelessness that him and John F Simpson that no receipt had been given

And further says not.
