Jasper Newton Rice “Newt” Jr. was born on June 5, 1867 to Jasper Newton Rice & Kesiah C Swindle in Gibson Co, TN. This section of Gibson County became Crockett County Tennessee in 1870. Newt married Nancy Jane Harbor on Nov 22, 1883 in Crockett Co, TN. Nancy was born March 19, 1861 and died Aug 15, 1908 in Crockett Co, TN. They are buried next to each other in Providence Cemetery, Crockett Mills, Crockett County, TN. His stone is a “Woodsmen of the World” stone

Jasper married Nancy Kathryn Anderson Grimmatt “Kate” on Nov 16, 1915, She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. W F Anderson. She remarried to Judge John A Hefley of Woodland Mills, TN on Aug 2, 1931, after Newt's death. She died May 12, 1951 and is buried with her last husband, Judge Hefley, at Union City Cemetery.

married M. Hauty (Hautie) Woods on Nov 21, 1909. Children Lurline b. 1912 Lurline married Lonnie Colvett Dec 21, 1935 Leon b. 1913 married Laverne Griffin Jan 1, 1935 Hautie Woods was b. May 17, 1891 d. Sep 9, 1971 Both are buried at Providence

Cemetery.

Algie Harrison Rice b. Sept 17, 1891 d. Jul 1972

Last residence was Memphis, TN married Morine Warren July 22, 1933

Ola Rice b. 1893 married Sam Dean Jul 21, 1921

Sam was born Aug 18, 1892. They resided in Crockett Mills in 1930.

They both died in 1976 and are buried at Providence Cemetery in Crockett Mills, TN

Isiah Newton Rice “Jack” b. Oct 27, 1895 d. Jan 1973

Last residence was Memphis, TN married Zula Linton Jan 29, 1929

Ruby Bell Rice b. May 6, 1898 d. Oct 4, 1989 married Fred Woodside Nov 25, 1917, she also married James Gordan Green Jan 21, 1924. James was born Oct 31, 1892 d. Dec 13, 1966, H Barton Green was his father. The couple are buried at Providence Cemetery in Crockett Mills, TN.

Mary Leather Rice b. 1901 married J C Smothers Jr. Dec 9, 1917

The couple resided in Jackson City, Madison Co, TN in 1930. JC was born July 8, 1894. Children: Doyle, Harrell & Darrell, and Jack.

Doyle resided in Tupelo, MS, Darrell in Lansing MI and Jack in Moran, WY at the time of Harrell's death in July of 1946. Harrell was 25 years old when he died at a Veterans Hospital in California where he was also buried according to his Obituary in The Crockett Times on July 4, 1946. He wounded in a Crash while patrolling in the Philippines.
