1. JOHN HIRAM² BAILEY (JOHN¹)¹ was born 15 Oct 1816 in Rutherford County, N.C.¹, and died Abt. 1885 in Folsom, Bartow County, Georgia. He married MALINDA DYE 02 Feb 1839 in Rutherford County, North Carolina, daughter of THOMAS DYE and SARAH PULLIAM. She was born Jan 1818 in North Carolina, and died Abt. 1904 in Folsom, Bartow County, Georgia.

Notes for JOHN HIRAM BAILEY:

Significant information about Hiram Bailey appeared in the Rutherford County Court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions for April 1832, page 91. Court minutes state, "The court bound Hiram Bailey, orphan of John Bailey, deceased, aged 15 years on the 15th day of October last till he attains the age of twenty one years to Claborn Burnett who agrees to teach him to read, write & cypher to the rule of three & give him at freedom a good suit of homespun clothes over what the law allows.

According to the Rutherford County Clerk of Superior Court Minutes, County Court, North Carolina, Hiram appeared as insolvent on the tax lists for the years 1847 and 1848 and was missing from any tax list for 1849. This researcher believes that 1849 is when Hiram and family relocated to Habersham County, Georgia along with his inlaws.

In June 1850, Hiram was in default of his taxes of \$.50 in the county of Habersham County, Georgia. This tax record clearly shows that Hiram did not own any land.

He appeared on the Bartow County, Georgia Tax Records for most of the period 1874 through 1884. It is believed that 1885 may have been the approximate death date for John Hiram Bailey; based on the fact that he never appeared on the Bartow County tax rolls following 1884. At no time did the value of his and his family possessions exceed \$75 value. During the period 1874 through 1884, he was not obligated to pay the poll tax probably because of his age.

5. GEORGE THOMAS³ BAILEY (JOHN HIRAM², JOHN¹) was born 14 May 1859 in Pickens County, S.C.¹³, and died 11 May 1934 in Folsom, Bartow County, GA¹⁴. He married MARY FRANCES PEACE 09 Feb 1882 in Adairsville, Bartow County, Georgia¹⁵. She was born Nov 1869 in Clayton County, GA, and died 03 Oct 1913 in Cassville, Bartow County, GA¹⁶.

Notes for GEORGE THOMAS BAILEY:

Extensive research into George Thomas "Tom" Bailey reveals that he never owned land. He made his living as a farm laborer, as did his father, John Hiram Bailey. According to one of his grandsons, Daimon Bailey, George spent the last few years of his life residing with some of his children, often arriving unannounced and without assets.

His obituary indicates he belonged to the Pleasant Valley Baptist Church for at least 49 years; later moving his membership to Crow Springs (both churches are located in the northern part of Bartow County, Georgia). Indications are that

his wife, Mary Frances Peace Bailey, also attended these churches. According to the Bartow County Georgia Heritage Book, Volume I, Page 45, Tom and Mary Bailey were among the earliest list of members at the Pleasant Valley Baptist Church.

Notes for MARY FRANCES PEACE:

Discovered the following at Bartow Historical Center during a genealogy trip in February 2007: The Cartersville News Number 61, Thursday, October 9, 1913, County News: "We are sorry to hear of the death of Mrs. (Mary) Bailey which occurred Friday night. Mrs. Bailey was well known and loved by all who knew her. A husband and several children survive her. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. C. A. Neal, of ATCO. The remains were laid to rest at Cassville cemetery.

Notes for ROBERT FRANK BAILEY:

On August 15, 1904 at the age of 18, Robert suffered an accident which had an impact on the remainder of his life. He was on a train to Cedartown which he boarded at Adairsville. At Cartersville he happened to an accident at the train station while departing the train. His right leg was badly broken just below the knee.

This caused him much pain throughout the remainder of his life. It was reported in The Cartersville News, March 9, 1905, Folsom area: "We are glad to report the condition of Frank Bailey, some better. He is able to be out again, for the first time since August, when he happened to a serious accident in Cartersville by being (trown) (sic) from a train.

Frank attended the Berry School in Rome, Floyd County, Georgia. It is confirmed that he was in attendance during the school year 1910 based on the Tenth Annual Catalog of The Berry School. His name in this catalog is listed as Bailey, Frank R. from Bartow County, Georgia. He is listed as being in the Grammar and Preparatory School. Several of his children indicated he worked at the school to pay for his education.

4 letter which is on file at the Berry College, Memorial Library Archive, which R. Frank Bailey wrote to Mr.

Robert Adams, Principal of Berry School, explains his reason for departing the school. He attributes his early departure from the school due to health reasons. In fact, he referenced that Mrs. Berry, the founder of the school, provided him with medicines. He emphasized that he wished to repay everyone for the costs they incurred on his behalf. The letter was dated December 29, 1910. Please note that his handwriting was excellent.

On September 12, 1918, Robert registered for the draft. He indicated that he was a farmer by trade and married to Lillie. He described himself as being medium height, medium build, black eyes and black hair.

His address was listed as Cass Station, Bartow County, Georgia.

During his lifetime he was a farmer; however in 1946 to 1947 his son, Daimon Bailey, located a job for him working for Allied Package. This company was responsible for shipping machinery from the old Bell Bomber Plant in Marietta, Georgia. Robert commented that this was the best money he had ever made, receiving

\$1.25 an hour. In 1947 he retired to Rome, Georgia.
