To any Regular Minister of the Gospel having the care of Souls, or to any Justice of the Peace for said County—Greeting:



~~These are to Authorize~~ you to solemnize the RITE OF MATRIMONY between Mr. Privett and Miss Nancy Rice of your County, agreeably to an Act of Assembly, in such cases made and provided; Provided always, that the said Nancy Rice be an actual resident of this County; otherwise, these shall be null and void, and shall not be accounted any license or authority to you, or either of you, for the purpose aforesaid, more than though the same had never been prayed or granted.

**Know all Men by these Presents,** That we Mr. Privett and W. B. Brown all of the County of Crockett, and State of Tennessee, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Tennessee in the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and each and every one of us, and them, jointly and severally by these presents.

Witness our hands and seals, this 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1879

**The Condition of the above Obligation is such,** That whereas, the above named Mr. Privett has this day prayed and obtained license to marry Nancy Rice Now, if the said Nancy Rice be an actual resident of the aforesaid County, and there shall not appear any lawful cause why the said Mr. Privett and Nancy Rice should not be joined in holy matrimony as husband and wife, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
