

## Perry G Dye & Mary Jane Baker

Perry G Dye was born in 1845 at Rutherford Co, NC to John Dye & Ailey Hill. The family moved to McMinn Co, TN when he was about 3 years old. Perry was named after his Great Uncle Perry, the brother of his Grandfather, Henry. Perry married Miss Mary Jane Baker on Sep 19, 1861 in Monroe Co, TN. She was the daughter of James C & Sarah Smith Baker of Monroe Co, TN. Her Siblings were: Elisabeth, Rachel A, Melborne, Wesley, and David E Baker. David married Tabitha Dye (daughter of Jennings Dye, Perry's Cousin)

Perry enlisted in the Union Army and served in the 8<sup>th</sup> Tennessee Cavalry Co B Private.

The Family appears on the 1870 Census for Grundy Co, TN; the 1870 Agricultural Census showing he owned 100 acres near Altamont, TN. In 1880, He resides in Bledsoe Co, TN. He appears last on the 1890 Veteran's Census of Dunklin Co, MO. The family moved to Dunklin Co, MO about 1882.

Perry G Dye died about 1890-1900 at Dunklin Co, MO, it is unknown where he and Mary Jane are buried.

The Children of Perry & Mary Jane Dye are:

**Calvin Dye** b. Oct 14, 1863 at Monroe or Grundy Co, TN. d. about 1900 at Dunklin Co, MO. Married Elizabeth T Duff May 6, 1883 at the home of W A Fisks in Holcomb, Dunklin Co, MO. Elizabeth died and he remarried to Zora Ann Wilson on May 7, 1891. The only children of Calvin are: Mary Lee Dye b. Dec 21, 1896 married TJ Collins Oct 23, 1925. Pearl Ann Dye b. Aug 31, 1900 Dunklin Co, MO and married Athel Mangold on Jan 20, 1917 at Dunklin Co, MO. Zora remarried after his death, She is living in Randolph Co, AR in 1910, She has two sons, Walter and William T. She is listed as Zora Dye on the 1910 Census.

**Sarah Jane Dye** b. Sep 6, 1865 at Grundy Co, TN d. Mar 2, 1909 Dunklin Co, MO buried at Gregory Cemetery, Kennett, MO Married Joseph F Dye, son of Shadrick and (1<sup>st</sup> wife) Susan Dye. He later married Martha and resided in Lawrence Co, AR about 1860. Joseph was born in Pike Co, Indiana about April 1861. His parents were from Casey Co, KY His Grandparents were John H Dye and Elizabeth Watson (married Jun 9 1824 at Casey Co, KY, his grandparents are very well known in the Dye line, They were William Shadrick Dye b. 1747 in Halifax Co, VA , a revolutionary war veteran, and his wife Sally Gordon. William was 1<sup>st</sup> married to Rebecca Randolph. There is some confusion over Williams Father, however, it is possible the lines meet at that point, as he is thought to be the son of Abraham Dye or and a grandson of Avery Dye. Sarah Jane Dye is missing from the 1880 Census with her family in Bledsoe Co, TN. It is possible she was just missed on the census. She was not yet married to Joseph as he appears on this census with his Family, at Strawberry, Lawrence Co, AR. They appear to

have married about 1880, probably after the census was taken in Lawrence Co, AR. In 1900, The family resided in Cleveland Co, AR; at Bowman Township. Children: Mabel b. Jan 1882; Cora b. Sep 1890 married Jesse J Smith at Dunklin Co, MO May 2, 1909; Pearl Agnes Dye b. Jan 1895 married Cecil Dunivan on Dec 20, 1920 at Dunklin Co, MO; Emma Dye b. Nov 1898. After Sarah died, Joseph remarried to Mrs. Laura Stewart on Sep 11, 1909.

**Obediah David Dye** b. Nov 13, 1869 at Grundy Co, TN and d. Nov 6, 1930 at Dunklin Co, MO. He is buried at Pine City Cemetery, Dunklin Co, MO. Obe married Sarah " Sallie" L Crittenden on Oct 21, 1888 at Dunklin Co, MO at the home of her father, Andrew J Crittenden. Sallie was born about 1873 at Graves Co, KY to Andrew J and Nancy E Crittenden. Andrew was born in Henry Co, TN. He had a brother Shelby Crittenden, who moved his family from Henry Co, TN to Greene Co, Arkansas and to Dunklin Co, MO. The children of Obe & Sallie are: Lena May Dye b. Nov 26, 1888 d. Nov 1, 1918, married Jasper Newton Dye on April 17, 1905 at Dyer Co, TN; Lela Ann Dye b. Dec 25, 1892 d. Aug 16, 1965 married Alfred "Alf" Burton Dye on May 1, 1907 at Dyer Co, TN. Sarah " Bessie" Dye b. Sep 18, 1896 d. Jun 3, 1966 in St. Louis, MO. She ran off and married Ernest Duncan when she was 13 years old. They had a daughter named Floraine Duncan b. 12 Sep 1909. After Sallie died, Obe remarried to Luvenia Floyd, dau of M & Fannie Wood Floyd, on Aug 12, 1900. They had a son Obediah Dye Jr "Obie", b. 1903, They divorced and he remarried to Lizzie Smith on March 25, 1911, After that marriage he remarried to Fannie Harris, and had the following children; Thomas Dye, Vackle Dye married Geo Linum, 11-21-1997, Chester Dye & Agnes Dye. Chester and Agnes died as children. Thomas Dye died in Michigan in the 1990's and Vackle Dye Linum died in Rector, AR in 2000, a mere 131 years after the birth of her Father. Luvena Floyd Dye died Sep 19, 1926 of Cancer and was buried a Oak Grove Cemetery, Dunklin Co, MO.

**Ada Dye** b. 1878 Bledsoe Co, TN Unknown

**Mary Dye** b. January 1883 in Dunklin Co, MO married Robert Miles on July 29, 1896 at Dunklin Co, MO. A Daughter Monica Miles was born November, 1897.
