

Thomas Dye and Juda Anna Dye

Thomas Dye was born in 1812-1823 at Rutherford Co, NC. He is the eldest son of William and Sarah Dye. He was named for William's twin brother, Thomas Dye.

Thomas was married in Rutherford Co, NC to an Unknown and had 1 known Daughter, Jane D Dye b. 1840.

Tom married his cousin, Juda Anna Dye b. 1830 Rutherford Co, TN. She was the daughter of John Dye Sr and his 1st unknown wife. Both Thomas and Juda were grandchildren of Henry & Anna Dye.

Tom & Judy were married in McMinn Co, TN on either June 30 or July 1 or 31, 1847.

The marriage license was issued on June 29, 1847.

“ I celebrated the rites of matrimony between the within named parties July the final/first day, 1847”

-- Tapley Gregory, Justice of the Peace.

• It is difficult to tell if they were married the final day of June and that July was the error on

Tapley's part or if the Final/First day of July is what it reads is correct or not? I tend to believe it is the final day of July which would be July 31st, 1847? For a time I thought it was the First, you can look and see what you think.

Juda was last seen on the 1880 Putnam Co, TN Census. It is assumed she died there in that year, because by the end of 1880 the rest of her children, including David Franklin and Juda Evie had moved to Dunklin Co, MO, where much of the family had relocated.

The Children of Tom & Judy are:

Alfred Dye b. Dec 1849 He was 10 months old on the 1850 census. Alfred Dye was buried at Nashville, TN at Nashville National Cemetery.

He died Jan 3, 1863 in the Civil War. He was captured Jan 1, 1863 according to civil war documents and died Jan 3, 1863 at Nashville.

Alie Dye married James M Jones on Aug 28, 1878 in McMinnville, Warren Co, TN.

They resided in Dunklin Co, MO near Holcomb & in Kennett, MO and in Stoddard Co, MO in

Dexter. Their Children include: Charles Jones and wife Harriett Welty, Mary E Jones and

husband Lewis Hutson, Elbert Jones, and Albert C Jones who married Maude Carmack and Loureen D. Unknown. Mary E Jones was born 29 May 1883 and died 7 Mar 1965 in Dexter, Stoddard Co, MO.,

She married Lewis Hutson b. 9 Sep 1878 in Carrier Mills, Saline Co, IL and died 11 Aug 1967

in Poplar Bluff, MO. They had Laura Ethel Edwards, Nobles, Vincent, Hurshel, Herbert C, Wilburn, Willis, Sylvia, Leatha, and Lucille "Babe" Hutson. Charles Jones married Harriet Welty and they had Goldie Jones and Everett William Jones. Everett Jones is buried at Pine City Cemetery, Dunklin Co, MO. Albert C Jones is buried with his wife, Loureen D. , at Stanfield Cemetery, Dunklin Co, MO. Alie died 2-10-1933 in Genesee Co, MI at the home of Elbert and his wife Hellen. James died Aug 26, 1934 in Genesee Co, MI.

David Franklin Dye was born in July of 1860 died after 1920 in Pemiscot Co, MO. He married his cousin, Louisa Eliza Dye b. 1864 Bledsoe Co, TN to Alfred Burton Dye and Sarah L Gilbreath. They married December 23, 1880 in Dunklin Co, MO.

They had Two sons, Alfred Thomas Dye and James Henry Dye. David married Missouri Elizabeth Champ on Feb 27, 1889 in Dunklin Co, MO. They had Annie Nettie Dye Crum, Georgia Lee Dye, Novis Perry Dye, Ivy O Dye and Myrtle Dye. He later married Mary E. Feisher Hamilton Newton on May 18, 1908.

Mary had a daughter named May Newton Crum who married the brother of Annie Nettie's husband.

James M Dye was born in February 1866 in Monroe Co, TN.

He married Martha Anna Watson on Dec 30, 1880 in Dunklin Co, MO and had two known sons, Riley Thomas Dye b. Nov 1892 and James Clarence " Dutch" Dye b. Jul 23, 1894. He married Myrtle "Mirtie" Mason about 1899 and had Thelma, Dallas "Buck", Buran "Jack" and Savannah Dye.

Juda Eva Dye " Evie" b. Jan 1868 Monroe Co, TN married Lemuel L Loyd, 14 Jul 1886, in

Dunklin Co, MO, he was the son of Nelson Loyd.

Children: Lula Loyd b. Jun 1888, Nelson L. Loyd b. Sep 1889, Clevie and Stevie Loyd (Twins)

b. Jan 1893, Laurie Loyd b. May 1892. Lemuel I. Loyd is buried at Lloyd

Cemetery in Dunklin Co, MO, his stone is overturned, lying flat and deteriorating.

Lemuel was b. Aug 16, 1867 d. Jan 8, 1897.

Evie's last address was Oak Street in Clarkton, MO in 1920.
