TO ANY REGULAR MINISTER OF THE GOSPEL. HAVING THE CARE OF SOULS,  
OR TO ANY JUSTICE OF THE PEACE FOR SAID COUNTY--GREETING:

These are to Authorize you to solemnize the RITE OF MATRIMONY between  
*William P Rice* and *Sarah Jane Reany*  
of your County, agreeably to an Act of Assembly, in such cases made and provided; provided  
always, that the said *Sarah J Reany* be an actual resident of  
this County; otherwise, these shall be null and void, and shall not be accounted any license or  
authority to you, or either of you, for the purpose aforesaid, more than though the same had  
never been prayed or granted:

Given under my hand at the Clerk's office, this *3* day  
of *Decem* 1872

Know all Men by these Presents, THAT WE,  
*W P Rice and J H Davis*  
all of the County of CROCKETT, and State of Tennessee, are held and firmly bound unto the  
State of Tennessee in the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, which payment well and  
truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and each and every one of us, and  
them, jointly and severally by these presents.

Witness our hands and seals, this *3* day of *Decem* 1872

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, the  
above named *W P Rice* has this day prayed and  
obtained license to marry *Sarah J Reany* Now, if the said  
*Sarah J Reany* be an actual resident of the aforesaid County, and  
there shall not appear any lawful cause why the said *W P Rice*  
and *Sarah J Reany* should not be joined in holy matrimony  
as husband and wife, then this obligation to be void; otherwise, to remain in full force and virtue.
